Q1. What should I do if the power indicator fails to light up?

**A**:

1. Replace the earth or hot wire fuse on the left of the pump.

2. If the issue persists, please contact your distributor for assistance.

Q2. What does it mean if the power failure indicator (yellow light) is on?

**A**:

1. Press Mute to turn off the buzzer.

2. Check if the outlet supply is normal and/or if there is a mains power outage.

**3.** Ensure the host power cord plug is secure.

Q3. What should I do if the selector failure indicator (yellow light) is on?

**A**:

- 1. Press Mute to turn off the buzzer.
- 2. Please contact your distributor for further assistance.
- Q4. What if the low pressure indicator (yellow light) is on due to an air leak at the quick connector?

**A**:

- **1. Press Mute to turn off the buzzer.**
- 2. Check if the black rubber oil seal from the quick connector is broken.

3. Ensure the quick connector is properly connected to the main device.

4. Verify that the quick connector is well connected to the tubes by the side of the mattress.

Q5. What if the low pressure indicator (yellow light) is on due to an air leak from the tubes by the side of the mattress?

**A**:

- **1. Press Mute to turn off the buzzer.**
- 2. Check if the tubes are broken.

3. Ensure the tubes are well connected to the mattress tubes.

Q6. What should I check if the low pressure indicator (yellow light) is on due to an air leak from the CPR emergency valve?

**A**:

- **1. Press Mute to turn off the buzzer.**
- 2. Check if the CPR emergency valve is closed.

3. Ensure the CPR emergency valve is connected to the tubes of the mattress.

Q7. What if the low pressure indicator (yellow light) lights up due to an air leak from the round one-way valve?

**A**:

- **1. Press Mute to turn off the buzzer.**
- 2. Check if the round one-way valve is broken.

3. Verify that the round one-way valve is well connected to the tubes by the side of the mattress.

Q8. What steps should I take if the low pressure indicator (yellow light) is on due to an air leak from the cells?

- 1. Press Mute to turn off the buzzer.
- 2. Check for any leakage from the cells.
